



## ON SITE SERVING LINE DECOR COMPETITION

Break out your best artistic skills for the first ever Serving Line Décor competition to be held on site using the conference theme of School Nutrition Rocks. ASNA districts, school districts or individuals are encouraged to form teams to enter the competition. The first 20 teams to register via the Google Form posted on the ASNA website ([www.alabamasna.org](http://www.alabamasna.org)) or the Alabama School Nutrition Association Facebook page **PLUS** pay the \$20 registration fee will be allowed to enter. Teams will be allowed to decorate their serving line between 5pm-6:00pm on Friday, April 21st. Make shift serving lines will be set up in the lobby outside of Ballroom A/B and marked with your team name. Serving line decorations will then be displayed throughout the evening on Friday and into Saturday morning. Winners will be announced during the Keynote & Awards Luncheon on Saturday, April 22nd. Please leave your entries displayed through 1:30pm on Saturday afternoon. Any decorations remaining after 4pm on Saturday will be discarded.

**Directions:** Please be sure to read all the instructions carefully and ask questions if something is not clear, prior to submitting your Google Entry form. If you have questions, please email them to [partain.casey@marshalk12.org](mailto:partain.casey@marshalk12.org). To avoid disqualifications, follow the competition rules EXACTLY. The biggest challenge judge's face each year is contestants being disqualified. Please make sure that you understand the requirements for the category you are entering.

All entries will be judged by those who understand the contest rules. The judges will consist of one member of the industry advisory board and two Child Nutrition Program directors. They will disqualify entries not meeting the requirements and rules of the competition. Disqualified entries will be identified with the reason for disqualification.

### General Information for all Participants

- Participants must be a Alabama School Nutrition Association member and attending the ASNA Annual Conference.
- No materials should identify the exhibit/item as that of a specific individual, school, or school system.
- Each entry will be given a number and judged by number not by personal identification.

### On- Site Serving Line Decor Competition Rules

- All entries must be original concepts and use the conference theme of School Nutrition Rocks.
- Exact dimensions and a picture of the makeshift serving line will be posted on the ASNA website ([www.alabamasna.org](http://www.alabamasna.org)) and the ASNA Facebook page for reference.
- All decorations should not be permanently adhered to the serving line. Please do not use staples, hot glue, gorilla glue, permanent/Expo markers or any other substance that would result in objects not being easily removed.
- Please do not cut holes or make punctures into any part of the serving line.
- Please follow the rules of the BJCC that do not allow for confetti, loose glitter or smoke.
- The entries must exemplify decorations actually used in Child Nutrition programs and that promote nutrition education, healthy eating, etc.
- There is no height or width restrictions but all objects must be displayed on/by the serving line and not adhered or supported by the walls to the BJCC.
- Please do not display real food. Pictures of food are allowed.
- A menu should be displayed of the foods that would be seen on the serving line if actually in a school lunchroom. Be creative!
- Tape, scissors, markers or any other art supplies will not be provided by the association. Come prepared with any needed supplies.

### Creative Arts Judging Criteria

(100 points is the maximum perfect score when judging)

#### -Overall appearance.....50 points

-Pleasing appearance, skill in assembly; Appropriate for occasion and use in school food service; Shows originality, appropriate colors, Shows wise use of time and materials

#### -Techniques and Designs.....50 points

-Demonstrates a unique design or idea; Creative and imaginative, consistent in design; Uses correct theme (School Nutrition Rocks)

### On- Site Serving Line Decor Awards

- Prizes will be awarded to the first, second, and third place winners. Judges reserve the right to limit awards if there are too few entries for adequate competition.
- People's Choice Award- Conference attendees can vote for their favorite entry by placing penny votes inside the gold box located at each serving line.
